- BYLAWS -

ARTICLE IV / PURPOSE

The purposes of the *Lt. General Victor "Brute" Krulak* Detachment shall be to:

- **1.** Band together current and honorably discharged/retired Marines, Fleet Marine Force Corpsmen, and Navy Chaplains in faithful camaraderie.
- **2.** Preserve the traditions and promote the interests of the United States Marine Corps.
- **3.** Effectively promote the ideals of American freedom and democracy.
- **4.** Fit its members for duties of citizenship and community service, and to encourage them to serve as ably as citizens as they have served the nation under arms.
- 5. Hold sacred the history and memory of the men and women who have given their lives for the nation.
- 6. Foster love for the principles they have supported by blood and valor since the founding of the Republic.
- **7.** Maintain true allegiance to American institutions.
- **8.** Create a bond of faithful comradeship between those in the service and those who have honorably returned to civilian life.
- **9.** Aid voluntarily and to render assistance to all current and former Marines, FMF Corpsmen, and Navy Chaplains, as well as to their spouses, children, orphans, and parents.
- **10.**Perpetuate the history of the United States Marine Corps, and by fitting acts to observe the anniversaries of historical occasions of particular interest to Marines, FMF Corpsmen, and Navy Chaplains.

- Business Meeting Protocol -

- 1. Members must wear their Marine Corps League red cover during meetings.
- 2. Members (regular and associates) must salute and be recognized by the Commandant prior to addressing the membership.
